PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

**May 18, 2022 - 4:00 P.M.
City Hall Conference Room**

CALL TO ORDER:

A meeting of the City of Clarksville Public Safety Committee was called to order by Councilperson Travis Holleman on Wednesday, May 18, 2022, at 4:00pm.

ATTENDANCE:

It was noted by Councilperson Holleman that there was a quorum.

Councilperson Vondell Richmond, Councilperson Karen Reynolds, Councilperson Travis Holleman

Others Participating: Building & Codes Director David Smith, Fire & Rescue Chief Freddie Montgomery, Chief of Police David Crockarell, Deputy City Attorney Eric Bittner, Assistant City Attorney Neil Stauffer, and Building & Codes Administrative Supervisor Deidre Ward

ADOPTION OF MINUTES:

The committee unanimously approved the minutes from the March 16, 2022 and the April 20, 2022 Public Safety Committee Meetings. This was after Councilperson Holleman made a motion to approve. It was approved by Councilperson Richmond and was properly seconded by Councilperson Reynolds.

BUILDING & CODES DEPARTMENT:

- David Smith spoke on behalf of Building and Codes.
 - He reviewed the previously submitted monthly report.
 - He noted the volume was up in comparison to the previous 2 years.
 - Mr. Smith discussed issues with recent homeless camp cleanups and suggested legislation be brought forth to assist. He asked for the Council's assistance and suggestions. Councilperson Holleman suggested all involved to do their own research and place this as a topic of discussion at the next meeting.
 - Mr. Smith opened the floor for questions. No additional questions were asked.

POLICE DEPARTMENT:

- Chief David Crockarell spoke on behalf of the Police Department.
 - He reviewed the previously submitted monthly report.
 - The police department is still hiring officers. They still have 16 vacancies (2 of which are on the civilian side).
 - C.P.A graduation is May 19, 2022. The next class is already full.
 - Chief Crockarell opened the floor for questions. No additional questions were asked.

FIRE & RESCUE DEPARTMENT:

- Chief Freddie Montgomery spoke on behalf of the Fire & Rescue Department.
 - He reviewed the previously submitted monthly report.
 - CFR has 1 tower down still. It has been in Nashville for over a month. They are unsure when it will be back in service.
 - CFR has 12 weeks left of the academy and 10 recruits currently enrolled.
 - Chief Montgomery opened the floor for questions. No additional questions were asked.

 - Councilperson Holleman explained the current ordinance, what is changing, and why.
 - Councilperson Reynolds asked questions in regard to the 'Citizenship' section of the ordinance.
 - Assistant City Attorney Neil Stauffer addressed Councilperson Reynolds concerns and touched on the ordinance changes.

- Motion to approve was made by Councilperson Holleman and seconded by Councilperson Richmond. The committee unanimously approved the resolution.

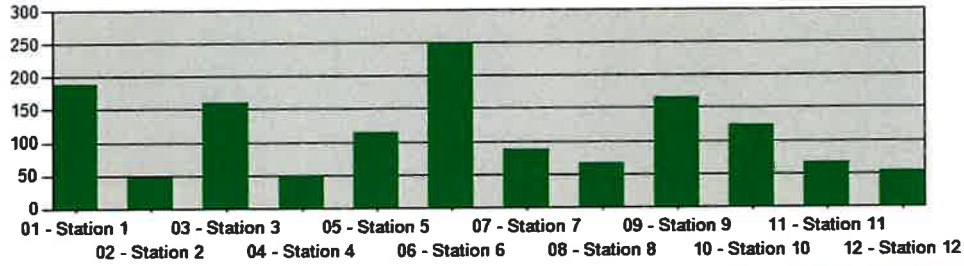

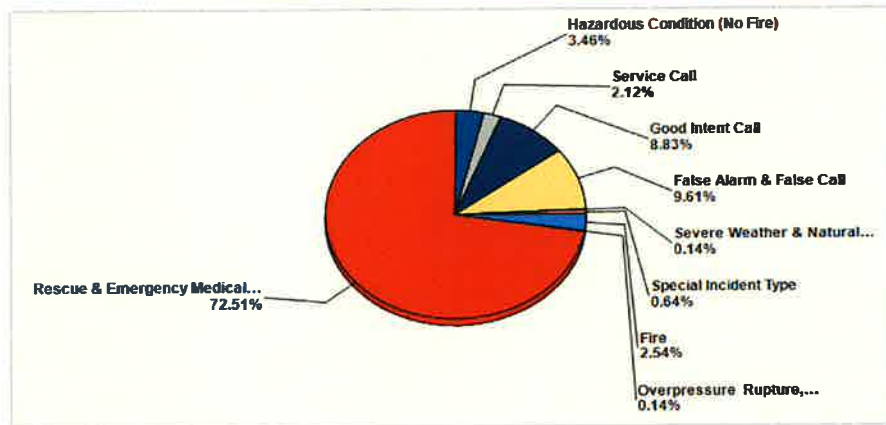
