ADOPTION OF MINUTES

DEPARTMENT REPORT

Interim Director David Smith, provided the following updates:

- Projects due to be completed this month – Kiana's House, Urban Ministries Safe House, and L&N Train Station. Ribbon cuttings coming soon.

- Tenant-Based Rental Assistance – 16 of the proposed 21 positions have been filled and it is anticipated that the placement goal will be increased to 50.
- Reconstruction – received bids back on 2 projects.
- Clarksville Neighborhood and Community Services received three awards from the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment Officials (NAHRO). Details will be published.
- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application process begins soon. Information regarding community workshops will be published soon. This will be discussed at next month's meeting.
