- a. The Task Force is committed to improving the quality, safety, and appearance of neighborhoods and commercial properties across the city. To achieve these objectives, the Task Force will focus on the following goals:
 - i. **Create a City-Wide Inventory of Neglected Properties**
Develop a comprehensive list of properties identified by the Building and Codes Department as neglected or abandoned. These properties will be assessed for their potential health or safety concerns to residents.
 - ii. **Devise Property Improvement Programs**
Collaborate with property owners, where feasible, to implement work programs aimed at cleaning up and improving these properties.
 - iii. **Recommend City Code Updates**
Identify potential amendments to existing city codes to enhance the enforcement of property maintenance and cleanup provisions and processes.
 - iv. **Promote Code Compliance**
Create strategies to encourage compliance with property maintenance codes across all neighborhoods.
 - v. **Provide Support for Property Owners**
Identify and promote resources, particularly for low to moderate-income areas, to assist property owners in cleaning up or restoring their properties.
 - vi. **Seek Grants and Redevelopment Programs**
Explore possible grants or programs aimed at redeveloping vacant, underutilized, or dilapidated properties. A key focus will be on properties along New Providence and Fort Campbell Boulevards to incentivize property improvement.

vii. **Other Necessary Tasks**

Undertake any additional actions deemed necessary to enhance the overall quality, safety, and appearance of neighborhoods citywide.
