- A. **ORDINANCE 54-2024-25** (First Reading) An Ordinance to amend the Official Code of the City of Clarksville Title 1 (Administration, Officers and Personnel), Chapter 9 (City Court), Section 1-909-Reserved to create a section relative to Municipal Court Expunctions and Fees. *Public Safety Committee: Approval*
- B. **ORDINANCE 62-2024-25** (First Reading) An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to conduct negotiations and to enter an agreement for purchase of a right of way and easements, or should negotiations fail, to pursue condemnation through use of eminent domain for acquisition of property for a public purpose for the City of Clarksville Needmore Road Improvement Project.
