James Barrineau spoke on behalf of Building & Codes.

- He reviewed the previous monthly report.
- The Construction Division had 3021 inspections.
- Code Enforcement Division had 338 new cases.
- Abatement Division 427 work orders.

- Total revenue for March was \$321,092.86.

B. Fire Rescue Reports

Chief Freddie Montgomery spoke on behalf of the Fire & Rescue Department.

- He reviewed the previous monthly report.
- CFR had 1565 runs with 71% rescue/medical calls.
- The Fire Prevention Division had 309 inspections and 22 burn permits.
- They will have 11 recruits graduate in mid May.
- The ribbon cutting ceremony for their new headquarters is on May 4.
- Councilperson Zacharias read a positive review on CFR off of Reddit.

C. CPD Reports

Deputy Chief Richard Stalder spoke on behalf of the Clarksville Police Department.

- He reviewed the previous monthly report.
- CPD had 15,254 calls for service.
- They have 28 recruits in the academy who will graduate in June.
- Cadet Interviews were held on Monday, and they hired 8. They will start the academy in July.
- They will have 13 out of the FTO program at the end of April.
